1. **EVENT DETAILS**

Event Type	Nirmalya Collection (Collection of religious waste during Ganesh Festival and Navratri Utsav)
Day & Date	Friday, October 7, 2022 11.30am

2. **CONCEPT OF THE PROGRAM**

Ganesh Festival is a Hindu festival celebrating the arrival of Ganesha to earth from 'Kailash Parvat' with his mother goddess Parvati/Gauri. The festival is marked with the installation of Ganesha clay idols privately in homes, or publicly on elaborate pandals (temporary stages). In Navratri Observations include chanting of Vedic hymns and Hindu texts such as, prayers and *vrata* (fasting). Offerings and prasadam from the daily prayers, that are distributed from the pandal to the community, include sweets. The festival ends on the tenth day after start, the idol is carried in a public procession with music and group chanting, then immersed in a nearby body of water such as a river or sea.

3. **OBJECTIVES**

- Prevent Water Pollution caused due to religious waste during Ganesh Festival
- Reuse the Nirmalya, floral waste, which is largely dumped after offering to the deity in the form of compost and recycle the dry

4. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
